Suffolk County Executive Steve Bellone and Suffolk County Legislator Tom Cilmi would like to invite you to a meeting for an update on the Great River sewer project, formally known as the Connetquot River Watershed Sewer Project. The meeting will be held on:

Since the last public meeting in November 2016, Suffolk County has been working to secure additional grant funding for the project. We are pleased to inform the community that these efforts have been successful and the County has secured additional funding for construction of the sewer system.

Updated financial information will be presented along with important information regarding the formation of a sewer district, opportunities for public input, construction details and a proposed/tentative timeline.

The Connetquot River Watershed Sewer Project is part of the Suffolk County Coastal Resiliency Initiative, a post-Sandy project intended to improve coastal resiliency by reducing nitrogen loading that degrades coastal wetlands that protect south shore communities from storm surge.

Citizen participation is a vital component of the project. We hope you will be able to join us for this important meeting.
