Date of Election: Tuesday January 22, 2019

Registration Cut- off Dates:

Last Day to Mail (postmark) Registration.....Friday, December 28, 2018
 (NY Election Law § 5-210(3) - 25 days prior to election)

Last Date to Receive Mailed RegistrationWednesday, January 2, 2019
 (NY Election Law § 5-210(3) - 20 days prior to election; must be postmarked no later than 12/28/18)

Last Date to Register (in person) at BOE- open 9 am to 5 pmSaturday, January 12, 2019
 (NY Election Law § 5-210(3) - 10 days prior to election)

Absentee Ballot Cut-Off Dates:

Last Day to Mail (postmark) Application.....Tuesday, January 15, 2019
 (NY Election Law § 8-400(2)(c) - 7 days prior to the date of election)

Last Day to Apply for Absentee Ballot (in person) at BOE (by 5 pm)...Saturday, January 19, 2019*
 (NY Election Law § 8-400(2)(c) - 1 day prior to election)

Last Day to Mail (postmark) Ballot.....Monday, January 21, 2019*
 (NY Election Law § 8-412(1) - 1 day prior to the date of election)

Last Date to Deliver Ballot to Polling Place or BOE (by 9pm)Tuesday, January 22, 2019
 (NY Election Law § 8-412(1) - date of election)

Last Date to Receive Ballot (Civilian).....Tuesday, January 29, 2019
 (NY Election Law § 8-412(1) - 7 days after election; must be postmarked no later than 1/21/2019)

Last Date to Receive Ballot (Military).....Monday, February 4, 2019
 (NY Election Law § 10-114(1) - 13 days after election; must be postmarked or signed and dated by voter and one witness no later than 1/21/2019))

* Note- Monday, January 21, 2019 is Martin Luther King Jr. Day, a Federal Holiday. Federal, State and Local Government offices, including the Suffolk County Board of Elections and the US Postal Service, are closed.
